Here are a few announcements that require our Chapter Operations and CTTC Chairs' attention:

Awards and Nominations: Chapter officers are encouraged to submit nominations for the prestigious Dan Mills Chapter Programs Award and the Donald A. Siller Refrigeration Award. These awards are an excellent opportunity to inspire your team and enhance member engagement in volunteer activities. You can either self-nominate or nominate a fellow chapter member.

Regional Technology Awards: The deadline for Regional Technology Award submissions is April 15. We urge you to motivate your members, local engineering firms, and real estate owners to submit their recently completed projects for an ASHRAE tech award. Despite being the largest ASHRAE region globally, Region I has seen fewer submissions than expected. There are numerous eligible projects in the NE region that deserve recognition.

Distinguished Lecturers (DLs): Allocated Distinguished Lecturers are still available and can significantly boost member engagement in your chapter. While three chapters have already invited their second DLs, some chapters have yet to invite any this year. If you're interested, please contact the DLs immediately and submit your requests before the budget is exhausted.

Submission Reminders: Please remember to submit forms for all DL visits—both allocated and non-allocated, in-person and virtual. Accurate records of all visits are essential. On the DL Participation Form, you can select 'Allocated Visit' or 'Unallocated Visit' at the top and indicate whether the visit is virtual or in-person in Section 9. The Event Summary Critique form provides valuable feedback on the DL's visit and helps track evaluation scores for each DL.
